"The wind blows where it wishes, and you hear the sound of it, but cannot tell where it comes from and where it goes. So is everyone who is born of the Spirit." - John 3:8

March is known as "the windy month." Gusts of air stir up the grass, rustle our hair, and lift our kites high above the earth. We can't see the wind, only observe its effects.

In the same way, as Jesus points out, we cannot perceive the Holy Spirit except through its manifestations. These manifestations abound throughout human history. Before time began "the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters" (Genesis 1:2). When God formed human beings from "the dust of the ground," He personally breathed His Spirit – "the breath of life" - into us (Gen 2:7). Throughout history, as portrayed in the Bible, the Spirit moved in judges, kings, and prophets. Then, with Jesus's victory over death and sin, salvation – and the Holy Spirit – became available to all persons. "For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free—and have all been made to drink into one Spirit" (1 Corinthians 12:13).

With Jesus's death and resurrection, the fulfillment of Joel 2:28-29 has begun: "And it shall come to pass afterward that I will pour out my Spirit on all flesh."

The Spirit enabled the New Testament John, exiled because of his faith, to be "in the Spirit on the Lord's Day." He heard "a loud voice, as of a trumpet, saying, 'I am the Alpha and the Omega, the First and the Last..." (Revelation 1:10-11). John's vision culminates in the final defeat of Satan, and God's recreation of "a new heaven and a new earth" (Revelation 21:1).

In Revelation 22:17, John gives an invitation for readers to participate in God's kingdom and His plan for his creation: "And the Spirit and the bride say, 'Come!' And let him who hears say, 'Come!" And let him who thirsts come. Whoever desires, let him take the water of life freely."
